Statement of the Welser Profile Group on the Use of Conflict Materials (US-Dodd-Frank Act)

Dear Sir or Madam,


Under the Dodd-Frank Act companies required to report under the U.S. Securities Exchange Act must disclose annually whether conflict minerals/raw materials necessary for the manufacture or function of their products originate in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or its neighboring countries. These conflict materials include columbite-tantalite (coltan), kasserite, gold, wolframite and their derivatives.

As a non-US listed company, the Welser Profile group does not fall within the scope of the above-mentioned law. However, the Welser Profile Group is aware of its social responsibility and is committed to acting in an environmentally conscious and ethical manner. Based on this, we confirm that none of our products contain conflict minerals. In addition, we also confirm that any small traces of conflict minerals/raw materials that may occur in the materials of the products we supply are there purely by chance. In such cases, this is an unavoidable minimal amount due to the high recycling rates for metals.


